

**SCHOLARSHIP****How to Be a Scholarship Student Candidate****1. Academic success**

Regardless of their financial situation, students having graduated from Açı Secondary School get a scholarship according to their Açı final grade point average of the Turkish, Social Sciences, Science and Technology, Mathematics, English and Second Foreign Language courses that they took in the 6, 7, and 8 grades. Scholarship rates are as follows:

- a. Students in the range of 85% – 89.99% get 25% scholarship.
- b. Students in the range of 90% – 94.99% get 50% scholarship.
- b. Students above 95% get 75% scholarship.

**2. Every Açı High School student gets a scholarship at the rates mentioned above according to their year-end grade average, providing that they also portray positive behavior and attitude.****3. National Team**

Students chosen to take part in a national team in any branch will get a 25% scholarship at Açı High School, providing that their grade averages are above 70% and that they also portray positive behavior and attitude.

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**4. Açı Teaching Staff**

The children of teachers who have been working in Açı Schools for one to five years, more than five years and more than ten years get 50%, 75%, and 100% scholarships respectively. Teachers' children maintain their scholarships only if they comply with all scholarship procedures. This procedure includes 25% scholarship for the second child of a teacher who has provided up to 15 years of service and 50% scholarship when the teacher has been working for 15 years and more.

**5. Financial Needs**

Açı High School offers scholarships to students who want to study, but cannot afford private



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schools.

- Açı High School students may apply for scholarship based on their financial needs.
- Applicants who apply for scholarship due to their financial needs are expected to fill in the Scholarship Application Form until the end of March every year. The Scholarship Application Form can be accessed on the Açı Schools website (<https://acischools.k12.tr/en/scholarship-opportunities/>).
- The right statement is essential for the scholarship offered based on financial needs.

### 6. Candidate Students

- As for the students who are candidates for a grade level , Açı High School offers 25% scholarship if they score 85% or more at the entrance examination and 50% if they score 90% or more. Success scholarship procedures are valid in the upcoming years.

### How to Maintain Scholarship

1. Success scholarships are annual; they are given directly according to the grade point average of the student at the end of each year.

Parents are informed via e-mail.

2. Financial need scholarships are annual. As long as the financial need continues, individuals should apply for this scholarship every year.

3. Participation in a national team has to be substantiated each year.

4. Students, who have a record of unabolished suspension at the year-end teacher council meeting, lose their scholarships.

5. Students, who have to repeat a grade level, lose their scholarships.

6. If more than one scholarships are obtained, the higher scholarship rate is applied. Only national team and success scholarships can be combined.

### Responsibilities of the School Administration

1. The school administration has the authority and the right to revoke the scholarship, if it appears that the principles of honesty and openness have been impaired by parents at any stage of the entire



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process.

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2. The school administration takes the necessary action for the student who receives the disciplinary penalty.
3. The school administration ensures that all official procedures (application forms, contracts, documents, correspondence, meeting notes, work schedules) of the students are prepared in accordance with established rules, that the documents are recorded, collected and kept.
4. The school administration interviews students who have previously received a success scholarship and observes their academic status at certain times.
5. The school administration evaluates the scholarship status according to the year-end grades of the students each year and informs parents and students about it.
6. The school administration reports in writing that the students who have received disciplinary penalties declared by the school administration have lost their scholarship.

### Parents' Responsibilities and Share

1. At Açı High School, the success scholarship rates are 25%, 50% and 75%. On the other hand, the financial need scholarship rates are different. Free student scholarship rate is 100%. Parents of these students pay their share in installments at the same time other payments are made..
2. Students who have not paid their share are not entitled to a scholarship again.
3. In the case of continuation of the scholarship, the changes in the new school year tuition fees are reflected in scholarships.
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4. For each school year for which the student has scholarship, s/he signs the Açı High School Scholarship Agreement and other required documents and delivers it to the school in time upon school administration's request.
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5. Parents respect the principles of honesty and openness. They inform the school administration when there is a change in their financial state.
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6. School services, teaching materials, school trips, national and international examination fees, in-school and out-of-school paid activities are not covered by the scholarship.

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
