



SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT

Responsibilities of the scholarship student

1. A student who receives a scholarship does not perform unacceptable student behavior. If the student is sent to the discipline committee, gets a suspension penalty and if the teacher's board does not cancel this disciplinary decision at the end of the year, he/she loses the scholarship.
2. The scholarship student shall be responsible for the supply of the school-related materials of his/her own, the lost school supplies, compensation for damages and the cost of excursions and such events. He/she knows that these are not covered by scholarship.
3. The scholarship student adopts and applies the honesty principle unconditionally in all his / her studies, school life and behavior. He/she contributes positively and constructively to school life: he/she assumes responsibility and fulfills his/her responsibilities in school activities, ceremonies, social responsibility projects, club activities, student council etc.
4. The scholarship student delivers all the project and research studies given to him, fully, qualified and on time. He/she studies in compliance with academic honesty principle. He/she does not attempt to cheating or plagiarizing and specifies the source for his/her work.
5. The student considers all directions of the advisor teacher, informs him / her when necessary and applies the decisions taken together. He/she is aware that the scholarship committee will consider the reports prepared by the advisor.
6. The advisor will meet with the family when the student fails to demonstrate the intended academic performance and the student fully complies with the work plan for progress.
7. He/she is aware of the responsibilities taken by the parents, the advisor and the school administration about his/her scholarship situation.



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Responsibilities of the Scholarship Student's Parents

1. They read scholarship procedures and contract; send an e-mail to the school office confirming that they read.
2. Fill out all the forms given by the school administration completely and correctly; when there is a change, update any information in the scholarship forms, in due time. Açı High School accepts and takes action based on the correct declaration principle until an opposite situation occurs.
3. The parents inform the school when there is a change in their financial situation that will affect the student's scholarship percentage in some way.
4. They cooperate with school administration and student's advisor. They meet with the advisor at the end of each semester and get information about the performance of the student.
5. They support and take responsibility for the implementation of the work schedule that the school has set to provide academic support in cases where it deems necessary for the student.
6. They shall know the responsibilities of the student, the advisor and the school administration about the scholarship status.

Scholarship Renewal Application and Assessment Schedule

1. Students who qualify for success scholarships are announced one week after the school closes. Registration renewals for students are done in April. The payment plan of students who become eligible to receive success scholarship will be revised in June.
2. For need-based scholarships, parents apply during the April registration renewal period. The scholarship commission is convened before the school closes. The registrations of the students who qualify for the need-based scholarship are made within the following week after the scholarship results are announced.

Scholarship Rates, Duration, Family Contribution and Scope of Scholarship

1. At Açı High School, success-based scholarship is awarded at 25%, 50% and 75%, need-based scholarship has at different rates.
2. The parents pay their contribution amount at the same time as the other parents' installment schedule. If the student's contribution has not been paid, he is not entitled to a renewal of the scholarship.
3. Scholarships are awarded annually. Applications are renewed each year.
4. School transportation services, education materials, school trips, national and international exam fees, in and out of school activities are not included in scholarship.
